This 2020 Convention Voter Guide contains information about the candidates, the voting software to be used, and the voting methodology. You will see candidates running for federal office, statewide office, state house and senate seats, and even state school board. There are also candidates who are running to be national delegates to the Republican National Convention, as well as those running to be Utah's presidential electors.

This printed guide will function much like a candidate booth in a regular convention. In a traditional convention, candidates purchase a booth from the party, get to know voters in the process, and that purchase helps defray the party's convention costs. We have had many costs associated with preparing for an online convention, including the printing and mailing of this guide. For that reason, I am grateful to the many candidates who have purchased ad space.

I would also encourage you to go to the Utah Republican Party's website, www.utgop.org. The party website will contain speeches by the candidates, and other information to help you get to know them and make informed decisions.

I trust that you will have an enjoyable and exciting convention experience, getting to know this amazing slate of Republican candidates. I am excited to see who you will choose to represent the Utah Republican Party in the general elections this November.

I am grateful for your service to our party, and want you to know that it is an honor to serve as your chair.

RANKED-CHOICE VOTING FAQ

Under the rules of the Utah Republican Party, when three or more candidates run for any election, the party can either use multiple rounds of balloting to eliminate candidates, or use what is commonly called ranked-choice voting ("RCV"). In past conventions, the party has used both methods. Because we have several races with a very large number of candidates, and we are using an online voting system, RCV is the most practical approach this year. You will have the ability to utilize your smartphone or tablet when you vote, and easily rank candidates from your first preference to the last with the software.

What is Ranked-Choice Voting, or RCV?

RCV allows a voter to rank multiple candidates in order of preference. Ballots are initially counted for each voter's top choice. If that choice is eliminated, the voter's second choice is counted and so on. Rankings are backup choices that never count against your top choice.

How does a candidate "win"?

RCV works like an instant runoff election.

A candidate advances to the primary if they receive 60% or more of the delegates' votes, whether in the first round of voting or in any subsequent round. If there are only two candidates left, and neither receives at least 60% of the vote, they both proceed to a primary.

How does the vote counting work?

If a candidate receives at least 60% of first choice rankings, then that candidate advances to the primary. If not, the instant runoff begins. The candidate with the fewest votes is eliminated, and the votes that were cast for that eliminated candidate are now counted in favor of the candidate ranked next on the ballot. This process repeats until either a candidate receives over 60% of the delegate votes and proceeds to the primary, or there are only two candidates left with neither receiving 60% of the delegate vote and both proceeding to the primary. With RCV, this entire process happens electronically and instantaneously, but otherwise is very similar to what happens when multiple round voting takes place in person.

I only like one candidate. What should I do?

You can certainly choose to only vote for one candidate, but you gain no advantage in doing so. If you only vote for one candidate and they are eliminated in a round of voting, and a subsequent round of voting takes place, it means that you have simply chosen not to cast a vote in that round.

Do I have to rank every candidate?


No. You can choose to not rank a candidate. However, not ranking other candidates does not give any extra "help" to your first choice.

What if I select the same candidate for every choice? Does that increase the "value" of the vote I am casting for that candidate?

No. It does not help a candidate if you only vote for them multiple times and no one else. If that particular candidate is eliminated after any round of voting, it simply means that you will not have a say in subsequent rounds.

What if there is a tie vote?

If the tie is between two last-place candidates, both candidates will be eliminated if their combined vote is less than the candidate with the next number of votes. Otherwise, ties are broken, per party rules, by a flip of a coin.



VOATZ REMOTE VOTING APPLICATION

We are excited to partner with VOATZ, the secure, online remote voting application we are using this convention. VOATZ has been used in official elections in states like Colorado, Oregon, and West Virginia. It was even used here in Utah last year for two municipal elections. Please follow the instructions below to download VOATZ, get verified as a voter, participate in test votes, and prepare for voting at the convention. For security purposes, VOATZ will use the email and phone number you provided to your county party. Please make sure that the email and phone number you provided the party are correct, and use those numbers when you create your account. Be sure to watch for any email instructions from the party about VOATZ as we get closer to the convention!

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Download and install the Voatz app from the App or Play Store from the QR codes to the right.
- Create an account with the phone number and email address you provided to the Party. You will be sent a verification PIN to your phone.
- When your account is verified and activated, you will be taken to the home page.
- From there you can select "Verifications" then "+ Add Organization". You will be provided with a Credential PIN by the Party to enter here to access your ballots.
- Prior to the Convention ballot being released, you will have access to a test ballot to verify your credentials.
- On the home page, simply select "Events" and your ballot will appear.
- After you've made your selections, you'll have a chance to review your ballot.
- When your ballot is submitted, you will receive a confirmation receipt via email.



A message from MIKE LEE

Now more than ever, it's essential that we nominate candidates who, when elected, will work tirelessly to restore, preserve, and protect the principles that have made our party—and indeed our republic—great. As Republicans, we are at our best when we are neither content with the status quo nor afraid to question the proposed expansion of government power. To that end, we should constantly ask ourselves (and each other) probing questions regarding the nature and proper role of government.

As I see it, government is best understood as an organized, official structure for the use of collective force. This overwhelming, potentially destructive power should be used cautiously and for defined, limited purposes closely connected to the defense of life, liberty, and property. Such power must be exercised at all times through the appropriate branch of government—with one branch making the law, another enforcing it, and yet another resolving disputes regarding its meaning. Of equal importance, government power must be wielded only at the appropriate level, with differences between state and federal authority remaining distinct and sacrosanct.

As you make your decisions at this historic convention, please take the time to research every candidate's position on basic issues regarding the role of government in general, the difference between state and federal power, and how each branch of government interacts with the other two. While once commonplace and expected in any election, these questions have sadly been neglected in recent decades—so much so that many candidates can't (or won't) identify any clear limits surrounding the office they seek.

In the Utah Republican Party, we know better. We can do better. And as we ask the right questions, we will do better, and lead our great country to a place where liberty and prosperity will once again be the norm. While asking the right questions won't always be easy or intuitive, finding answers should be. Your questions might differ from mine, but here are some of the questions I intend to ask:

- 1. (for those running for governor, lieutenant governor, or state legislative office): Would you support legislation repealing SB 54, recognizing the right of political parties to determine the means by which they select and nominate candidates?
- 2. (for those running for governor, lieutenant governor, or state legislative office): Utah has long been applauded as the best-run state in the nation, but we still have plenty of problems. What are the top five changes you would make to state law?
- 3. (for those running for governor, lieutenant governor, or state legislative office): What would you change about our state's public education system? Would you support a voucher system? What support should the state provide to parents who homeschool their children. either in connection with COVID19 or otherwise?

- 4. (for those running for federal office): Please describe the difference between state power and federal power—identifying at least five areas in which the federal government is acting where it should not—and identify legislation you would support to return power to the states.
- 5. (for those running for federal office): Although the Constitution vests all federal lawmaking power with Congress, over time Congress has delegated much of that power to unelected, unaccountable bureaucrats. The resulting Byzantine labyrinth of federal regulations cost the American economy an estimated \$2 trillion each year, disproportionately harming America's poor and middle class. What would you do to return federal lawmaking power to the branch of government most accountable to the people at the most regular intervals?
- 6. (for all candidates): The federal government owns roughly 2/3 of the land in Utah. While essentially no one in Utah wants to disturb national parks, national recreation areas, wilderness areas designated by Congress, or military installations, most federal land in Utah doesn't fit into any of those categories, and keeping all of that land under federal control inflicts great harm on our state's economy, environment, tax base, affordable-housing market, and public education system. How much of Utah should the federal government own, and what changes to state and federal law would you support in this area?
- 7. (for all candidates): What is the purpose of government?
- 8. (for all candidates): Setting aside specific constitutional prohibitions, what are five things that no government, state or federal, should ever do?
- 9. (for all candidates): Should any person in Utah be denied equal protection under the law, based solely on whether the person in question has been born?
- 10. (for all candidates): Please identify five ways in which governments pick "winners and losers" in the economy, indicating whether you support or oppose each approach.
- 11. (for all candidates): Please explain why you are a Republican, what it means to be a conservative, and whether or to what extent the word "conservative" describes your approach to public policy.
- 12. (for all candidates): Do you support President Trump's re-election?

I remain convinced that, although we face many new, unique, and vexing challenges, our best days remain yet ahead of us. Anxiously awaiting better times, we must do our part to make sure that our government facilitates (and does not impede) their arrival. We can. We must. And together, we will!


